The different steps to reserve your Césal accommodation:

Creation of your resident space

Create your resident space (if you are studying at CentraleSupelec, please use the same email address as the one you provided to the school)

Choose your arrival date

Select your arrival date and time. This date will be the starting date of your lease. Except for the future 1A CentraleSupélec students, all leases will start at the latest ten days after the reservation date. If you are not asked to select an arrival time, our managers will contact you via gestion@cesal.fr to determine a time with you.

Choosing accommodation

Choose the accommodation that suits you (building, floor, PRM, balcony...)

4 Give your end date

Enter your end date (within a limit of 11 months after the start date of the lease). Please note that some accommodations must be vacated by a specific date. If the accommodation you select is one of these, this will be specified when you make your reservation.

5 Download the supporting documents.

Upload the required supporting documents to your resident space within 48 hours:

- Identity card Proof of schooling for the current year
- Proof of address
- Proof of home insurance starting on the date of arrival in your accommodation (think of our partner STUDCORP [https://studcorp.com/habitation/]
- If you are calling on a physical guarantor: identity document and the most recent tax notice or tax status notice, or the guarantor's last three payslips
- If you are calling on a moral guarantor: certificate of rental guarantee (Our partner Garantme [https://www.garantme.fr/fr/cesal] offers you the possibility of obtaining a moral guarantor at a preferential rate by entering the code "CESAL" at the time of payment!)

6 Validation of supporting documents

Our teams validate your documents.

Pay the security deposit + rent.

Pay your security deposit and first rent via your resident's area.

8 Sign!

Last step is the electronic signature! (rental contract, internal regulations, direct debit mandate, security deposit).
